ADMONITION  
PROTECTIVE ORDER

The Review Committee considered materials submitted by the grievant, respondent and disciplinary counsel, and the applicable rules, statutes and case law:

**ORDER**

The Review Committee orders an Admonition pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Washington Supreme Court’s Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct.

**PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Under ELC 3.1(b)(1) the materials submitted to the Review Committee are public with the exception of materials subject to a protective order under ELC 3.2(e). The Review Committee orders that portions of documents on the record before it shall not be public, but that dissemination otherwise consistent with the ELC is not prohibited:

The Review Committee enters a protective order for any portion of the record before it where dissemination would conflict with the Federal Court orders issued on 6/28/2017 and 2/13/2019 in U.S. District Court case entitled *Moi v. Chihuly Studio, Inc., et al.*, No. C17-0853RSL (W.D.Wash.).<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> Respondent has argued, *inter alia*, that the information at issue in the Federal Court’s orders was at all relevant times in the public domain. *See, e.g.*, MOI 002979, MOI 000690-000711. The Federal Court, having heard Respondent’s arguments, issued an order dated June 20, 2019 with a “clear disapproval of [Respondent’s] actions.” MOI 000753.
