This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 18-Month Suspension entered into by Shari Ann Brown, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on November 1, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined by a majority that an order approving the Stipulation to Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:
