This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Twelve Month Suspension. The stipulation indicates that Mr. Booth requests that the suspension be effective April 1, 2020, and the Office of Disciplinary Counsel does not oppose that request. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a twelve-month suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Harold M. Turner is suspended from the practice of law for twelve months effective April 1, 2020. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Mr. Turner shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and he shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
