This matter came before the Supreme Court on the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Harold M. Turner, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation of suspension. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer's Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that the order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

Harold M. Turner is suspended from the practice of law for six months with reinstatement conditioned on payment of the outstanding costs and expenses owing in the 2008 admonition proceeding, 08#00016, and in this proceeding, including interest. As of August 24, 2014 the total amount is \$1,337.85. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, as approved by the disciplinary board, and restitution, pursuant to ELC 13.7, as approved by the disciplinary board, will be paid by Harold M. Turner.
