This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 18-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Catherine Susan Willmore, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 17, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Catherine Susan Willmore is suspended from the practice of law for 18 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Ms. Willmore shall comply with the terms of the stipulation including payment of \$2,000 restitution and payment to the Washington State Bar Association of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$1,000 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
