- 2. Respondent has also failed to show any credible evidence of disability during that time period that impacted his ability to exercise due diligence in that regard.
- 3. Respondent failed to timely comply with the Amended Order Directing Supplemental Proceeding with respect to the requirement that he timely file and serve a proffer of all evidence he intended to offer at the Supplemental Proceedings as required therein.
- 4. Respondent has failed to show good cause for failing to timely comply with the Amended Order Directing Supplemental Proceeding.
- 5. Respondent has failed to show good cause under ELC 10.12 (g) to continue the supplemental hearing.

Based on the foregoing findings of fact, the Hearing Officer hereby Orders as follows:

- 1. Respondent's Motion to Continue the Supplemental Proceeding is hereby denied.
- The Supplemental Proceeding previously set to commence on December 11, 2017 is hereby stricken.
- This matter is hereby returned to the Disciplinary Board for further handling under ELC 11.
