DISCIPLINARY BOARD ORDER ADOPTING HEARING OFFICER'S DECISION WITH INCREASED SANCTION

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its May 6, 2011 meeting, on automatic review of Hearing Officer Kimberly A. Boyce's November 8, 2010, decision recommending a two-year suspension.

Having reviewed the materials submitted by the parties, heard oral argument and considering the applicable case law and rules;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Hearing Officer's decision is amended as follows: The Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law are adopted. The recommended sanction is increased to disbarment.¹

¹ The vote on this matter was 8-1. Those voting in the majority were: Bahn, Handmacher, Ivarinen, Lombardi, Ogura, Stiles, Trippett and Waite. Mr. Butterworth voted in the minority and would have approved a three-year suspension. Mr. Butterworth agrees with the hearing officer that [Respondent's] "inexperience, the dire circumstances created by Mr. Velasco's prior attorney, Respondent's sincerely held motive to act quickly enough to avert a disastrous outcome for him, and the fact that she was left alone by the partner to cope with all of this..." justify mitigating the presumptive sanction of disbarment to a three-year suspension.

1	The Board finds that the mitigating factors do not outweigh the aggravating factors
	and that the presumptive sanction of disbarment is appropriate. The decision will be sent to
2	the Supreme Court for final action.
