

¹The vote on this matter was 8-3. Those voting to approve the stipulation were: Carney, Denton, Louvier, Andeen, Byerly, Graber, Patneau and Cornelius. Because of the gravity of Respondent's conduct in abusing fiduciary relationships and the substantial amounts he paid to therapists, doctors and tow truck drivers to refer business to him, Silverman, Cottrell and Myers would have conditionally approved the stipulation if the parties were to agree to disbarment.

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
