Lyle Bradley Bosket is currently an active member of the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA). By order of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, dated January 24, 2018, Mr. Bosket was suspended for 30 days, with all of the suspension stayed pending successful completion of a one year probation term. Mr. Bosket was disciplined because he neglected his client's legal matter, in violation of ORPC 1.3, and failed to respond to a client's reasonable requests for information, in violation of ORPC 1.4(a). Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Bosket to inform this Court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. Mr. Bosket filed a response on February 20, 2018. The WSBA filed a letter replying to the response on March 2, 2018. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and has determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court hereby imposes reciprocal discipline in the State of Washington. Lyle Bradley Bosket is suspended for 30 days effective February 1, 2018, with all of that suspension stayed pending the successful completion of the one-year term of probation imposed by the State of Oregon.
