ORDER IMPOSING FOUR-MONTH SUSPENSION PURSUANT TO STIPULATION

This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to Four-Month Suspension. The stipulation was signed by Diane Sweet and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on April 1, 2019.
