This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 21-Month Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Sengphachahn J. Livingston, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on May 15, 2017. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the Stipulation to 21-Month Suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Sengphachahn J. Livingston is suspended from the practice of law for 21 months. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Sengphachahn J. Livingston shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
