REPRIMAND

Under the Rules for Enforcement of Lawyer Conduct promulgated by the Supreme Court of the State of Washington, you have been directed to receive this FORMAL REPRIMAND.

In representing a client in a collection action against in a debtor, you twice signed affidavits prepared by your employees containing false information. You then filed the affidavits with the court.

Your conduct in failing to supervise your non-lawyer employees and in twice filing affidavits with the court without verifying the accuracy of the statements therein violated of RPC 5.3 and RPC 8.4(d).

These actions merit a Formal Reprimand. Your actions discredit you and the legal profession and show a disregard for the high traditions of honor expected from a member of the

1 Association.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY REPRIMANDED by the Washington State
3 Bar Association for this misconduct. This Reprimand will be made a part of your permanent
4 record with the Association, and will be considered along with other evidence regarding any
5 future grievances against you.

6 Your privilege to practice law in the State of Washington is based on the finding that
7 you are a person of good moral character, and on your commitment to abide by the rules
8 governing the conduct of members of the Association. The Association expects all your future
9 conduct as a lawyer to be consistent with that finding as to your character, and with a continuing
10 commitment on your part to the letter and spirit of those rules.


