On January 18, 2023, the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho entered an Order suspending Robin Lynn Haynes from the practice of law in Idaho for five years with two years of the suspension withheld. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Robin Lynn Haynes to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. On February 22, 2023, the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) filed a motion for disbarment. On April 10, 2023, Robin Lynn Haynes filed a response. On April 17, 2023, the WSBA filed a reply. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined by majority that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The WSBA's motion for disbarment is granted and Robin Lynn Haynes is hereby disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Washington. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
