This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation. The Court (Justice Whitener did not sit) reviewed the order and the stipulation, and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 60-day suspension should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Drew D. Dalton is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Reinstatement to the practice of law is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. The lawyer shall be subject to one year of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and shall comply with all of the terms of probation as specified in the stipulation.
