This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a stipulation to three-year suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Andrea Salinas and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on September 5, 2012. The Court reviewed the order and the Stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Andrea Salinas is suspended from the practice of law for three years. The suspension shall be effective May 1, 2012.
