SUSPENSION ORDER

This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) Disciplinary Board’s order in the matter of Merwin Moe Spencer, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the hearing officer’s recommendation that Merwin Moe Spencer be suspended for a period of three years. The Court (Justice Whitener did not sit) reviewed the Disciplinary Board’s order and the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officer’s Recommendation and the Court determined unanimously that this order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

Merwin Moe Spencer is suspended from the practice of law for three years followed by probation for a period of 24 months beginning on the date Merwin Moe Spencer is reinstated to active status to practice law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Merwin Moe Spencer shall comply with the conditions of probation specified in the Finding of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Hearing Officers Recommendation.
