This matter came before the Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Approving Stipulation to 3-Year Suspension. The stipulation was signed by Jill J. Smith, her counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on September 24, 2018. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined unanimously that an order imposing a 3-year suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

## ORDERED:

Jill J. Smith is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Reinstatement is subject to the conditions specified in the stipulation. Ms. Smith shall be subject to two years of probation beginning on the date of reinstatement and she shall comply with all of the terms of the stipulation.
