On February 12, 2020, the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA) entered an Order disbarring Alexander Ying-Chi Chan from practicing before the BIA, the Immigration Courts, and the Department of Homeland Security. Upon notification of the action of the BIA, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Chan to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. On May 11, 2020, Mr. Chan filed a response. On June 10, 2020, the WSBA filed a reply. Mr. Chan was allowed to file a surreply on June 19, 2020. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined by majority that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and therefore Alexander Ying-Chi Chan is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the dated of this order.
