On November 19, 2019, the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois entered an Order suspending Christopher Craig Anderson from the practice of law in Illinois for one year. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Anderson to inform the court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. On December 20, 2019, Mr. Anderson filed a response accepting imposition of reciprocal discipline identical to the discipline entered in Illinois, requesting an effective date of the suspension of December 10, 2019. On December 27, 2019, the WSBA Office of Disciplinary Counsel filed a letter indicating they do not oppose having the suspension effective December 10, 2019. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined by majority that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Christopher Craig Anderson is suspended from the practice of law for one year. The suspension shall run concurrent with the Illinois suspension and therefore will be effective December 10, 2019.
