This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving Stipulation to Disbarment pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Chris Crew, his counsel and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on October 18, 2016. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined by a majority that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Chris Crew is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order. Chris Crew shall pay to the Washington State Bar Association attorney fees and administrative costs of \$2,000 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i).
