This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's Order Conditionally Approving Stipulation To One Year Suspension and Probation and Protective Order dated October 19, 2016 under ELC 9.1. The Court reviewed the order and the amended stipulation and determined unanimously that an order approving the stipulation to suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Mark Magnus Larsson is suspended from the practice of law for one year. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order. Mr. Larsson shall also be on probation for a period of two years commencing on the date of this order. Mr. Larsson shall comply with all of the terms of the amended stipulation including payment of attorney fees and administrative costs of \$500 in accordance with ELC 13.9(i). Reinstatement from suspension is conditioned on payment of the \$500 and compliance with the terms of probation as outlined in the amended stipulation.
