On October 13, 2017, the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals entered an order suspending Mr. Marsh from practicing before that Court for one year based on failure to properly handle numerous immigration cases pending before that Court. The Court considered the discipline imposed by the United States Court of Appeals Ninth Circuit and the files herein at their En Banc Conference on April 5, 2018, and filed an order staying this reciprocal discipline matter pending the outcome of the supplemental proceedings pending at the WSBA based on the assertion of a disability. On September 12, 2018, the Washington State Bar Association filed a copy of the "ORDER TERMINATING SUPPLEMENTAL PROCEEDING (ELC 8.3(d)(6)(B) AND ELC 10.1(c))" that was entered on September 7, 2018, by the hearing officer for the supplemental proceedings. The order terminated the supplemental proceedings. On September 14, 2018, the Court's stay pending the outcome of the supplemental proceedings was lifted and the matter was circulated to the Court for review. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and has determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court hereby imposes reciprocal discipline in the State of Washington. Samuel Campbell Marsh is suspended from the practice of law for one year. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
