DISBARMENT ORDER

Supreme Court No. 201,830-1

This matter came before the Supreme Court to consider the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order in the matter of Samuel Campbell Marsh, wherein the Disciplinary Board adopted the Findings and Recommendations entered by the hearing officer that Mr. Marsh be suspended for one year for Count 1 of the complaint and disbarred for Count 2. The Court reviewed the Disciplinary Board's order and the hearing officer's Findings and Recommendations and determined unanimously that this order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

For the failure to provide competent representation to his clients, Samuel Campbell Marsh is suspended from the practice of law for one year. For submitting documents containing a forged client signature to a tribunal and an immigration officer, Mr. Marsh is disbarred. Because Mr. Marsh is currently subject to an interim suspension, both the suspension and the disbarment shall be effective on the date of this order. Mr. Marsh shall pay restitution as provided in the Hearing Officer's recommendation and ELC 13.7. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, shall also be paid by Mr. Marsh.
