ORDER APPROVING  
STIPULATION TO A THREE-  
YEAR SUSPENSION

This matter came before the Court on the Washington State Bar Association Disciplinary Board's order approving a Stipulation to a Three-Year Suspension pursuant to ELC 9.1(c)(2), entered into by Sean Elliott Nyberg, his counsel, and WSBA Disciplinary Counsel on October 5, 2015. The Court reviewed the order and the stipulation and determined by a majority that an order approving the stipulation to a three-year suspension should be entered. Now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

Sean Elliott Nyberg is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is 7 days from the date of this order. Costs and expenses, pursuant to ELC 13.9, in the amount of \$1,573.87, will be paid by Sean Elliott Nyberg.
