On February 27, 2024, the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona entered an Order suspending Nicholas Smith from the practice of law in Arizona for three years, effective January 19, 2024. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Nicholas Smith to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Nicholas Smith did not file a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Nicholas Smith is suspended from the practice of law for three years. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of suspension is seven days from the date of this order.
