On March 1, 2018, Megan M. Perry resigned in lieu of discipline from the Oregon State Bar. The Supreme Court of the State of Oregon accepted the resignation by order entered April 5, 2018. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this Court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.4, directing Ms. Perry to inform this Court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in this state would be unwarranted. Ms. Perry was served with the order on April 16, 2018. As of this date, Ms. Perry has not filed a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered. Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Pursuant to ELC 9.4(d), Megan M. Perry is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
