On March 10, 2022, the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon entered an Order disbarring Micah David Fargey from the practice of law. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Oregon, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mr. Fargey to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. Mr. Fargey did not file a response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington and therefore Micah David Fargey is disbarred from the practice of law. Pursuant to ELC 13.2, the effective date of disbarment is seven days from the date of this order.
