On July 18, 2023, the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona entered an Order suspending Mark Walter Heckele from the practice of law in Arizona for six months and requiring the completion of a probationary period of two years. Upon notification of the action of the Supreme Court of the State of Arizona, this court issued an order, pursuant to ELC 9.2(c), directing Mark Walter Heckele to inform this court of any claim that the imposition of identical discipline in the state would be unwarranted. On September 8, 2023, Mark Walter Heckele filed a response. On September 11, 2023, the WSBA filed a letter regarding their reply to the response. The Court reviewed the file in this matter and determined unanimously that the following order should be entered.

IT IS ORDERED:

The Washington State Supreme Court does hereby reciprocate discipline in the State of Washington. Mark Walter Heckele is suspended from the practice of law for six months and required to complete a probationary period of two years. The suspension is effective on August 18, 2023.
