ORDER CONDITIONALLY APPROVING
STIPULATION (ELC 9.1(e))

ACTION REQUIRED

This matter came before the Disciplinary Board at its July 9, 2021 meeting.

On review of the April 2, 2021 Stipulation to Suspension, the Board finds that the stipulation, as submitted, would result in a manifest injustice given the pattern of misconduct involving the unauthorized practice of law.

IT IS ORDERED that the stipulation is approved¹ on the parties' agreement to add the following condition:

The length of the suspension will be changed from 6 months to 18 months.


This stipulation, as conditioned, will be deemed approved if both parties serve written consent to the conditional term. The written consent must be served on the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order.

The Board will reconsider this decision if the parties file a joint motion requesting reconsideration. This motion should be in writing and filed with the Clerk within 14 days of service of this order. The parties may ask to address the Board.

¹ The vote on this matter was 6 to conditionally approve, 3 to approve as submitted. Those voting for conditional approval were: Rene, Kroon, Kraski, Hermes, Pratter, and Wolfe. Gates, Marsh, and Koch would have approved the stipulation as submitted. Hurl, Valdez, Doyle, Singleton, and Devenport did not participate.


1 If either party fails to respond to this order in writing within 14 days, the Board
2 will enter a final order rejecting the stipulation.
